# 1. 2021 IASPM meeting

- KL reports that the meeting of the local committee is planned for next month.
- About the conference theme (climate): KL suggests to switch to Euro-Asian pop, but after
  discussion, we agree to continue with the theme of climate as it is highly inclusive and does not
  limit to any region in particular. This term includes organizational climate, social climate,
  political climate, flows, environment, medium, ambient, milieu, etc. Some of the topics of the call
  should be political climate, ecological issues, and ecomusicology, technological climates, space
  and place (subcultures, localities, scene), development in Asian musical cultures.
- Title: "Climates of popular music."
- RT will write a draft of the call via google docs or email thread. The idea is to rotate it with the local committee to have their input as well.

### 2. Book prize

#### 3. Newsletter

- BG reports that local branches have mostly abandoned the idea of newsletters. IASPM newsletter is outdated (2016). Most branches have news sections, only Australia and New Zealand have a newsletter. She recommends switching to another model.
